### **Non-Discriminatory Policy**

The policies and procedures under which the **Muslim Judicial Council Halaal Trust [MJCHT]** operates and administers its business is non-discriminatory.

The MJCHT's halal certification services are accessible to all applicants whose activities fall within the scope of the operation. All applications shall be treated fairly and without prejudice or discrimination due to its size, type of business, financial position, or political background.

MJCHT may, in its sole discretion, decline to accept an application or maintain a contract for certification from a client where justified reasons exist, such as any act or omission by the client which harms or threatens to harm the good name and reputation of the MJCHT. The MJCHT may also decline an application if the client participates in illegal activities, is non-compliant with certification/product requirements, and any client issues which in the reasonable opinion of MJCHT adversely impacts on the relationship of trust between the part.
